Meet Benji and How He Became a Therapy Cat

One day, my husband was with his mom at the hospital while she was having some tests done. While Terry was out in the waiting area, a man stopped by with his dogs as part of a pet therapy program. My husband and this man chatted for a bit, and my husband mentioned how we had a cat at home who had the potential to be a therapy cat. Turns out the man was Mike Gray with Divine Canines, and he said while the program he was working through didn't take cats, his wife Nancy worked with a different program, Therapy Pet Pals of Texas (TPPT), and they have had cats in their program. Shortly there after, I contacted TPPT and found out that their requirements for cats were pretty simple: be current on vaccinations and be of a temperament that can tolerate on demand petting. Benji and I were invited to the TPPT office, and Benji was judged of appropriate temperament to be a therapy pet pal. Our training consisted of three visits supervised by an experienced volunteer to potential destination facilities. Our visits went well, and we became fully certified as TPPT volunteers. We visit two facilities each twice a month (one per Saturday), and Benji sits in his bag and visits anyone who wants to pet his super soft pelt-like coat. Unlike some of the dogs in the program who are excited to go on their TPPT visits, Benji is not keen on his job. He actively avoids me and even grumbles at me when I gather him to get ready to volunteer. He somehow knows the difference between when I'm approaching him to get him ready for a hike vs when it's time to go volunteer. However, despite his grumbling, he is the best best boy when we are doing our volunteer visits. He is always patient and calm with the people who pet and visit with him, and this is not always the case with me or the vet! I think he senses how much he helps with his warmth and softness.
